It appears Telstra has not announced yet that you can increase the speed of your CABLE (i.e. HFC not ADSL) connection and there is an easy way to get it.

All that is required is to turn off your cable modem for 20 secs then turn it back on. This reboots the modem to accept the new configuration.

Cable plan - Base Plans

Download speed: Will change from 36Mbps to 55Mbps

Upload: Will change from 1Mbps to 5Mbps

Cable with Speed Boost plan

Download: Will remain the same

Upload: Will change from 2Mbps to 5Mbps

These speeds are approximate.
