What's been happening

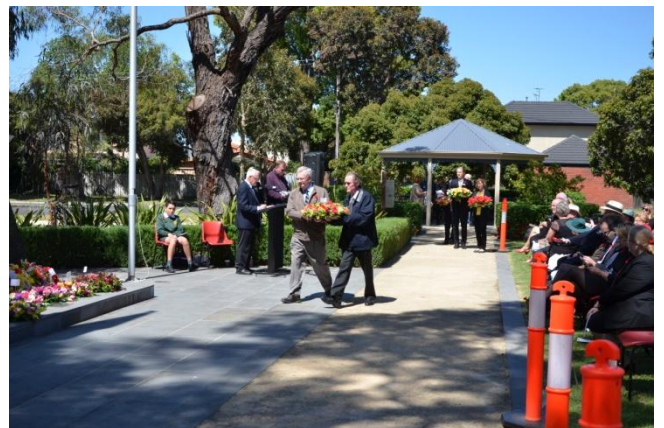
