We will acknowledge all support given through a sponsors process currently being developed.

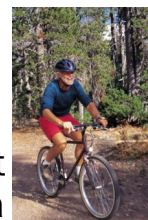
Currently we estimate we will need a minimum of \$110,000 to have both sheds fully operational. If we can source materials at wholesale or donated, we reduce this amount.
