## Shed clean up begins

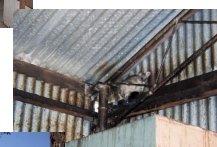
After what at times has seemed a long & complicated process, we finally can start cleaning up the Sheds at Braeside Park.

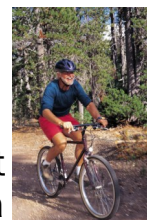
